To fill the gap of M.Ed. qualified teachers in the Banaskantah district of North Gujarat region Banaskantha Kadva Patidar Sanskar Mandal started first self financed M.Ed. College named as Shree Banaskantha Kadva Patidar Sanskar Mandal College of Education from the Academic Year 2008 -09. College was started with affiliation of Hemchandracharya North Gujarat University, Patan and recognition for full time M.Ed. programme was given by Western Region Office of National Council of Teacher Education, Bhopal. The college was renamed as Shrimati Revaben Karshanbhai Devabhai Khanushiya College of Education (M.Ed.) from Academic Year 2012-13.

Academic Year for 2023-24 started with first semester from 15-06-2023. Beginning with the academic year our M.Ed. students got orientation about course requirements, library referencing and the regular instructional sessions. The students began working on their dissertations by seeking advice from their respective guides. ACADEMIC INFRASTRUCTURE

Psychology Resource Centre

The college has state of the art Psychology Resource Centre (Lab) that is meant for testing and measurement of all psychological dimensions/areas which are essential for successful implementation of all teaching learning activities. Psychology Resource Centre is equipped with various psychological tests i.e. Intelligence test, Aptitude test, Personality test, Memory test, Attitude test, Learning test, Alexander Pass Along test, Social behavior, Scientific Aptitude etc. The Psychology Resource Centre has a collection of over sixty nine standardized tests, which are used by students, research scholars and faculty, on a regular basis. Psychology Resource Centre equips the student teachers with requisite skills on how to understand their pupils in the class and also to learn to administer psychological tests.



Library as academic Learning Center



The library provides several services through a team of dedicated staff. The collection of documents/ research work / books and thesis are over three hundred. Membership is open to all faculty, staff, scholars, college teachers and students. We express gratitude to our management for contributing enormous amount to the library for the purchase of books. Our library is richly equipped with 10000 Books. Library is

technologically uplifted with a collection of 116 Encyclopaedia, 08 Research Surveys, 07 Year Books, 16 National Journals, 02 State Level journals, 41 National and State level magazines and five multilingual news dailies. Library Week is being celebrated in our institution as a routine practice every year.

Computer Laboratory

The College has a well-equipped Computer lab, with 60 computers along with internet facility at 100 Mbps, offers challenges for research to M.Ed. scholars in the field of computer education, curriculum development, and creation of a database for digital films, development of CAL material, online learning material and so on.



Multi Media Room

The College has a well-equipped Multi Media Room, situated in the Building. The Multi Media Room has several kinds of projectors, including a Film Strip Projector, Overhead Projector, Slide Projector and LCD Projector, etc. There is a good audio system in the lab. The lab is used by the

students of all the courses, and sometimes by other institutions also throughout the year.

E-Resource Room

The E-Resource Room is well equipped with computers, CD Rom, E-Journals and internet facility for its M.Ed., M.Phil. And Ph.D. scholars. The research scholars use this facility throughout the year for exploring and enriching their dissertation and thesis.



Classrooms

All the classrooms have very good seating facilities, along with the black boards. Larger classrooms are well-equipped with ceiling mounted LCD projectors and audio systems, in the larger classrooms. Some of the classrooms have round tables for small group cooperative sessions.



Seminar Hall

College has one State of Art Seminar Hall fully equipped with public address system, Waiting room, Smart LCD projector, Playback facilities for highly audio/video, Central AC, 500 plus seating efficiency with all primary facilities.

M.ED. PROGRAMME

The Master of Education (M.Ed.) programme is a significant step in the preparation of Educational Researchers, Educational Administrators and Teacher Educators. The M.Ed. students, apart from receiving a rich grounding in educational theory, take up Dissertation work and a Field-based project in diverse areas which include Foundations of Education, Special Education, Mental Health Education, Language Education, Mathematics Education, Science and Social Science Education, Teacher Education, Educational Technology, Curricular and Pedagogic issues. The M.Ed. Students are also being professionally developed for tutorship and school supervision. To develop their research acumen and potential, regular in-house Research Seminars are conducted every week where the M.Ed. students make presentations. Beginning with the academic year our M.Ed students got orientation about course requirements, library referencing, Psychology laboratory visit, computer laboratory visit and the regular instructional sessions. The students began working on their dissertations by seeking advice from their respective guides. They also contributed their part and gained experience by guiding B.Ed students during internship.

7. Generate a sense of belongingness and commitment towards the environment.
8. Integrate technology in the task of teaching and learning.
9. Comprehend various philosophies and their role in education.
10. Expose the aims, learning strategies, discipline and experiences of education.
11. Develop reflective outlook towards the emerging challenges in the field of education.
12. Enhance communication, entrepreneurship and employability skills.
13. Equip themselves with administrative and managerial skills.
14. Develop analytical and interpretative as well as assessment and evaluative skills.

ADMISSION CRITERIA:

Admission For M.Ed Course is made on merit on the basis of marks obtained in the qualifying examination.(Graduate –post Graduate and B.Ed Examination). Admissions are made by Hemchandracharya North Gujarat University Patan. There is a Provision that 15% Admission can be made by the trust as per the criteria fixed by the University. SEMINAR/WORKSHOP/SYMPOSIUM HELD FOR YEAR 2023-24

Dissertation (Selection of the Problem+Online Review):

Student has to select an educational topic for the dissertation which is approved by the university before the end of semester -II. For this students were given hand on experience for selection of their own dissertation topic during seminar in the college. Student have reviewed the past (minimum ten) researches of their selected research area and identified the research gap and from that they have finalized the research problem. As a follow up student have submitted and presented their research problem with with PPT presentation of atleast 10 topics related with their selected topic in front of committee of the college. College committee with discussion approved the topic for its further submission to University. The assessment of the student was done based on the presentation.

Communication and Expository Writing

One workshop of two days on communication skills and one workshop or Group Discussion for two days on expository writing is part of two years M.Ed. programme. Expository writing is writing that seeks to explain, illuminate or 'expose' (which is where the word 'expository' comes from). This type of writing include essays, newspaper and magazine articles, instruction manuals, textbooks, encyclopedia articles and other forms of writing for academic purpose, so long as they seek to explain. Expository writing differs from other forms of writing, such as fiction and poetry. There are different types of expository writing that are used for different purposes. Students have Maintained report of each workshop and Evaluation was done on the basis of report/test/Presentation.

Research Proposal & Tool Construction

On the basis of the title selected in semester – I Students were asked to Present and discuss the proposal in front of research committee of the institute and Prepared/selected required tool/s for their subject and submitted final tool. As a prerequisite for this process students are given exposure through seminar/workshop in college with ample opportunity to work with hand on practice. Under the respective supervisors instruction students have prepared their research proposal and research tool for their dissertation and submitted to the college. Evaluation was carried out on the bases of written/typed proposal according to the steps of proposal and presentation. The tool selection/preparation was assessed by its validity and reliability of the tool according to the need of the research topic.

PROCEEDINGS of SEMINAR

One day national seminar on “Indian Knowledge Systems” was organized by Matrushri S. S. Govinda and Shrimati R. K. D. Khanushiya College of Education (M.Ed.), Palanpur (NCTE Code-325049, NAAC Accredited-B), Affiliated with Hemchandracharya North Gujarat University, Patan, Gujarat (College Code-280) on **04 November 2023**.

National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 aims for a complete metamorphosis of the higher



education landscape of the country in all its structural, content-related, and pedagogical dimensions. The rich heritage of ancient and eternal Indian knowledge and thought has been a guiding light for NEP-2020. The NEP 2020 has stressed upon the promotion of Indian Languages, Arts and Culture, and has recommended for the integration of IKS into curriculums at all levels of education. Indian Knowledge Systems (IKS) (Bhāratīya-Jñāna-Parampara) encompasses the

treasure of knowledge in various disciplines that emerged systematically from the ancient times in India over generations. Integrating IKS in curriculum for capacity building in faculty and educating the students as envisaged by NEP 2020 requires strengthening the role of the faculty and evolving them into energized, motivated, and capable faculty. Faculty of Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) require additional familiarization efforts through Teacher training/orientation for the Indian Knowledge Systems. Integration of IKS in the curriculum at various levels involves an introduction to IKS, its Scope & History, and amalgamation of fundamental IKS concepts into modern textbooks, leading to developing Indian Thought Models based on available IKS literature, and their application into various contemporary problems solving methods.



Hence with a view to above stated NEP guidelines the purpose of this Seminar was for the awareness of teacher trainee and refresher cum induction programme for faculty to provide a roadmap to familiarize them about the Indian Knowledge Systems (IKS) and identify strategies to incorporate IKS into their specific classroom teachings.

Participants of the Seminar will acquire the concept of the Indian Knowledge System and apply it in real life for the advancement and creation of knowledge.

The National Seminar started with Inauguration ceremony by lighting the lamp with Saraswati Pujan by all the dignitaries and the National seminar started under the Chairmanship of Chief Guest eminent educationist Dr. Girishbhai Thakar, Veteran Officer on Special Duty, Somnath Sanskrit University; Dr. J.
