AUTHOR'S PAPER SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Abstract:

An Abstract should be in-between 150-200 words with 3-5 Keywords and should contain Objectives, Methodology, Sample, Tools and Key Results/findings.

Main Paper:

Papers should be a maximum of 3000 words (including references in APA Style, graph, chart and table). The final manuscript should be prepared in MS-Word, 12-point (font size) for English and 14-point for Gujarati (Shruti Unicode) and Hindi (Mangal), with 1.5-spaced (Line and Paragraph). Leave margins (1") on all sides of the page. English manuscripts should be prepared in Times New Roman, Gujarati in Shruti and Hindi in Mangal fonts.
